Apostolic Infiltration: The Kingdom Realm on EARTH!!!

Ephesians 2:6, Psalms 115:16

The concept of the Kingdom Realm is not primarily one of space, territory, or politics, as in a natural kingdom, but it is seen as the power and righteousness that resides in a believer. In Romans 14:17(AMP) it says, “for the kingdom of God is not *a matter of* eating and drinking [what one likes], but of righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. ¹⁸For the one who serves Christ in this way [recognizing that food choice is secondary] is acceptable to God and is approved by men. ¹⁹So then, let us pursue [with enthusiasm] the things which make for peace and the building up of one another [things which lead to spiritual growth].”

It is the presence of God living in us that bring the Kingdom Realm on earth. The continual presence of the holy spirit in our lives gives us an advantage that enables us to operate from a supernatural place with heavenly access to the resources, riches, and the rulership of God. Apostolic Infiltration is about understanding that we are kingdom citizens with the ability to become the answers, solutions, and ideas on earth. Infiltration happens when we are sensitive to God’s voice, subject to his word and submitted to his will in every aspect of our lives this includes our area of influence. Our sensitivity gives us the ability to tap into the supernatural imagination, intelligence, creativity, ingenuity, innovation, and divine wisdom of God. Apostolic Infiltration happens as God releases his gifts in the earth with authority, dominion, and power to bring impact, influence, and inspiration. For Apostolic Infiltration to take place the believer must possess the proper perspective in the following areas. Altitude, Attitude, and Aptitude. Coming into agreement with the Word of God is the only way that believers can bring heaven to Earth.

- I. **Your Spiritual Altitude: Divine Positioning and Maturity** - Spiritual altitude has everything to do with where the believers abide from a heavenly perspective, their level of authority, and the access they have through their spiritual adoption. It is crucial for us to rise in our belief of who we are and in the realm in which we reside. You’re gifting and fivefold office is not what gives heavenly access and earthly dominion, it’s your sonship. We were made as kings and priest in the earth. This truth is so important to understand because we often confuse our identity with our function. Knowledge of your function will come with relationship and submission, however having knowledge of your identity in Christ is what will cause your spiritual altitude to increase. Now let me be clear, there are unique authorities that the apostle, prophet, pastor, teacher, and evangelist walk in, however if they don’t have a clear understanding of their identity, they will operate from a place of gifting and not power and positioning.

Our altitude also speaks to our spiritual maturity. As Kingdom citizens there must be a pursuit to become the reflection of our heavenly father in word, deed, and behavior. We must set an intention to operate from a place of love. The clearer you are of your spiritual authority and positioning, the more humility you demonstrate, because there is an understanding of just how fragile we are without God’s power working in us.

- II. **Your Spiritual Attitude: Renewed Mind and Divine Alignment** – Our devotion, our set intentions to come in agreement with the word of God and our willingness to be followers of Christ

is what aligns our heart and mind with God. Our devotion speaks to our submission and sacrifice to God. Alignment also has to do with the believer getting to the place where they can see themselves as God sees them and operate on earth as HE leads them. This requires the believer not leaning to their own understanding, but purposing in their hearts to trust God's direction. Believers must understand that their natural mind is in constant competition with their spiritual mind. Apostolic Infiltration will require the believer to execute the word of God and their full authority on earth to bring impact, influence, and inspiration to all those they encounter. It's about demonstrating the essence, nature, and glory of God on earth.

III. **Your Spiritual Aptitude: Capacity and Substance** – A believer's capacity and substance has everything to do with the power, passion and purpose that is at work in them. Capacity depicts the bandwidth (energy and mental capacity) that each one of his people holds for the purposes of carrying out the assignment of God. We all have been given a purpose and the power necessary to fulfill God's plan. Purpose is not a specific destination but a divine path that God has predestined for each of his children. The more the believer knows the Lord, the clearer their purpose and assignment becomes. The believer must be willing to endure the price of their assignment and purpose, knowing that God has given them all spiritual blessings needed to fulfill their destiny. Apostolic Infiltration will require the believer to be activated in their purpose and assignments on earth. The key to do this is to understand that **wherever we are**, we can breathe life into dead situations and be the solutions to problems through the power of God. It is imperative that the believer not limit their impact, influence, and inspiration to one specific area, but posture themselves to be glory carriers that are subject to the holy spirit. When we are subject to the holy spirit, we operate from the infinite imagination and wisdom of our heavenly father.

Apostolic Infiltration and Impact can be stifled when the believer does not have a clear and true understanding of the power that they have been given to bring impact, influence, and inspiration on the earth. Many have abided in the place of our a) humanity, b) natural efforts and c) within microcosms for too long. Abiding in our humanity simply means that we have not allowed ourselves to move beyond our nature and propensity for error. We have become stuck in our soulish realms, which include our opinions, natural abilities, and perspectives. A microcosm is a small subset of a whole, which can be churches, institutions, and/or organizations. These are living, breathing entities, which has its own set of rules, culture, and functioning. The problem is that people often become imprisoned by these entities because they don't understand the vastness of God's grasp on the Earth. The people of God are often seeking positions and titles, caught up in personalities/fanfare/loyalties and when this happens, they neglect the power, presence and constant pursuit of the heart and mind of God. We run the risk of fulfilling man's purpose and not the purpose of God. This can lead to spiritual abortion and/or the stifling of God's gifts.

Raising our level of awareness of the authority that we possess on earth will help the believer to go beyond the comfort and security that a microcosm provides, causing them to trust God more and launch out into the deep. Some of us have been comfortable for too long and are at a place of spiritual frustration and stagnation. And God is saying come higher, I have created you for so much more. The more presence driven, spiritually empowered, and confident in their identity the believer becomes, the greater the chance for Apostolic Infiltration and Kingdom Impact on Earth.
